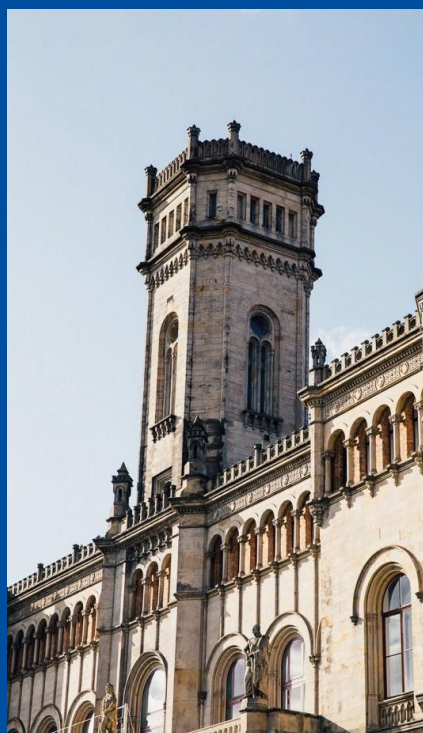
HANNOVER

APPLICATION INFORMATION

University Nomination: Nominate students via email to Anne Höch (exchange-incomings@zuv.uni-hannover.de) and cc Yin Wang (yin.wang@zuv.uni-hannover.de). Nomination deadlines are 30 Apr for winter semester, Oct 31 for summer semester.

Student Application: Nominated students will receive an email from Anne Höch to apply via the application portal "MoveOn" and then email the following documents to anne.hoech@zuv.uni-hannover.de:

- PDF of the MoveOn application, signed by the home university's exchange coordinator
- Learning Agreement, signed by the student and student's home university exchange coordinator
- Transcript of records from home institution
- Copy of passport (if available)
- English B2 proof required for courses taken in English.
- German B2 proof required for courses taken in German.

Application deadlines: 31 May for winter semester, 30 Nov for summer semester.

Housing, meals and insurance: Students apply for housing through the international office on a first-come, first-served basis. Housing is limited. Affordable meals are available at the cafeterias (3 - 6€ for lunch). Students must have health insurance that meets German government requirements, e.g. German public insurance (ca. 128€/ month). The International Office of LUH will be happy to answer questions you may have.

Pre-Semester Intensive German Course: An optional 4-week is offered during the month before the semester starts. Course cost is approx. 350€.
